COMMITTEE UPDATE REPORTS:

MAINTENANCE COMMITTEE: Committee Board Chair- John Zutman

- COURT CLEANING: Courts to be cleaned by the Maintenance Department every four weeks.
- Steve met with Rich Bass about changing court cleaning hours due to member concerns. It was decided that courts 1, 2, and 6 will be cleaned on Wednesdays at 10am. Remaining courts 3, 4, and 5 will be cleaned on Sundays at 7am.
- The hitting net on Court 5 is deteriorating and also proposing a safety risk; John will contact Robson to arrange for its donation or disposal within a couple of weeks.
- Robson plans temporary crack repairs between Courts 4 and 5 in 2026, followed by permanent repairs in 2027.
- Courts 1 and 2 are scheduled for resurfacing in August, exact date dependent on weather.
- New ball containers have been ordered, and the containers for recycled plastics will be removed.
- New scoring towers have been ordered.
