
**Summary:**


2024 YTD 12/31/24 Bank reconciliation summary reconciled with 1 outstanding check at year end.

2024 YE cash balance increased \$320.12 over the previous year as income was \$320.12 greater than expense for 2024.

During 2024 there were 31 total disbursements of which 7 were over \$200 accounting for 71% of total disbursements. The 7 disbursements over \$200 have been reviewed and all receipts are in order.
